Location:	At Penn Street, which is just off the A404 between High Wycombe and Amersham. Penn Street is signposted at SU924965, HP7 0QW . Public transport: Train to High Wycombe or Amersham, then 20 minutes by Carousel Bus number 1 (broadly an hourly service), alighting at junction of Penn Street with the A404 (at SU924965), then 800m walk.
Parking:	At commercial premises at SU923956, adjacent to the Hit or Miss pub, Penn Street, HP7 0PX. Parking is limited, so please share transport . Free parking - your entry fee includes a donation to a charity of the landowner's choice.
Terrain:	The areas are ancient woodlands. Penn Wood and Penn Estate are generally flat, as is Common Wood but it has a steep north-facing slope. The woods are very varied with a mixture of conifer, beech and oak, and some open areas. There are many pits / depressions as a result of ancient clay and flint workings. The area was previously used for the Southern Night Champs in December 2017, and a regional event the following day.
Map:	Scale is 1:10,000 with 5m contours. Shorter courses will run in Penn Wood, size A4. Longer courses will include the adjacent Common Wood, A3 size. The map has been resurveyed and updated to ISOM2017 by Bob and Pattie Beresford.
Courses:	Full range of colour-coded courses White - Black Check the website to see which course to run for your age class.
Entries:	Online at www.fabian4.co.uk . Pre-Entry closing date - midnight on Sunday 10 th February 2019. There will be limited EOD subject to map availability.
Fees:	Pre-entries - Seniors £14.00 (£16.00 non BOF/IOF), Juniors & Students £7.00. Late & EOD - Seniors £16.00 (£18.00 non BOF/IOF), Juniors & Students £8.00. Adult beginners on White, Yellow & Orange £7 if pre-entered, otherwise £8. Note: These fees include a per capita land access charge & parking. EMITag hire: Those with an EMIT brikke get free hire, otherwise hire fee £1.50. Lost EMITags charged at £45.
Starts:	From 10.00 to 12.30. Courses close 14:00. Registration: 09.30 - 12.00
Facilities	Toilets, First Aid, Tom's burger-van, Ultrasport. Well-behaved dogs allowed on their leads in the car park. Being a National Event, TVOC's policy is no dogs to accompany competitors. Please clean up after your dog.
