

# **TVOC invite you to an Orienteering Event on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2010 at LANGLEY PARK**

**This event, one in a monthly Saturday Series, is open to all, beginners, improvers and anyone who fancies a challenging outdoor adventure sport enjoyed by people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds.**

**Family friendly introduction to orienteering with experienced club members on hand to give beginners guidance. A compass is not essential.**

**Event Location** Bucks County Council Langley Park Country Park,  
Car Park, Billet Lane, Near Iver, Bucks.  
Car park: - OS Grid Ref. TQ 016822 Landranger 176 West London

The car park is 600m South of A412 dual carriageway and 500m West of the Crooked Billet roundabout near Iver Heath i.e. just South of Black Park. It is 5 to 6km from the A40 Gerrards Cross, Uxbridge, M4 Slough East and Jn 1 M40 at Denham.

**Parking fee** Council Car park fee: £2.50 ticket per vehicle from coin machine - to be displayed on your windscreen. N.B. There is a vehicle headroom limit of 1.8m. There is a new small cafe selling toasted sandwiches, cakes, hot & cold drinks, etc. There are new loos next to the cafe which is 100m from the car park.

**Registration** 1030am to 1130 in the SW corner of the car park.  
Starts from 1030am to 1200. Courses close at 2pm.  
The Start and Finish will be near the car park.

**Fee** £2, which includes one overprinted and bagged map unit and the hire of an EMIT electronic timing unit. Map is 1:7500 newly surveyed November 2010 to take in the substantial work done on improving the park following a Lottery grant.

**Terrain** Generally level terrain, many tracks and paths, huge sequoias and deciduous woodlands interspersed with mown open areas. Some courses will visit the Arboretum and the recently coppiced rhododendron garden with its maze of upgraded wide gravel paths.

**Courses** White, Yellow & Orange:- These three courses are for beginners and recent improvers. Both these courses can be followed on footpaths or wide rides. There will be a longer Green course for more experienced orienteers.

**Results** EMIT punches will be used. Results on Club website as below.
