Location:

Hambleton, nr. Henley-on-Thames

Parking:

Large, dry field off A4155, approx. 2 miles N. of Henley

Terrain:

Undulating, runnable, mature Chiltern woodland. Mix of mature and thinned beech, and coniferous plantation. High visibility with little ground vegetation. Fast.

Map:

Based on previous map for NE2 (2005) and JK 2003. Updated 2010/11 by Mark Thompson and John Farren. Scales: 1:15,000 (A4) or 1:10,000 (A3 and A4) 5m contour interval. Pre-marked, waterproof

Courses:

Elite courses: M/W18, M/W20 and M/W21

M/W21E courses will be seeded and allocated start times according to British Orienteering rules by the Elite Competitions Group

Full range of age-based courses for M/W10-M/W80

UK Masters Cup: Competitors wishing to score UK Masters Cup points in an age-class must enter the appropriate Long course for that age-class

You must be a Local or National member of British Orienteering to enter the age-based courses

No EOD for age-based courses
