REVISED DIRECTIONS TO ASSEMBLY AND PARKING

Location: The assembly area is situated in the village of Naphill approx. 6km. north of High Wycombe town centre.

Revised Travel Directions

Take the A4128 north out of High Wycombe passing Hughenden Manor on the left hand side at 2.3km. Continue for a further 1.3 km to second mini roundabout and turn left for Naphill. The assembly and parking is after a further 1km on the left hand side. **GR SU 854965**

Terrain: The area is on the Chiltern chalk escarpment and is mainly deciduous forestry. In common with the Chilterns there are many paths, it is undulating and longer courses may find a reasonable amount of climb.
